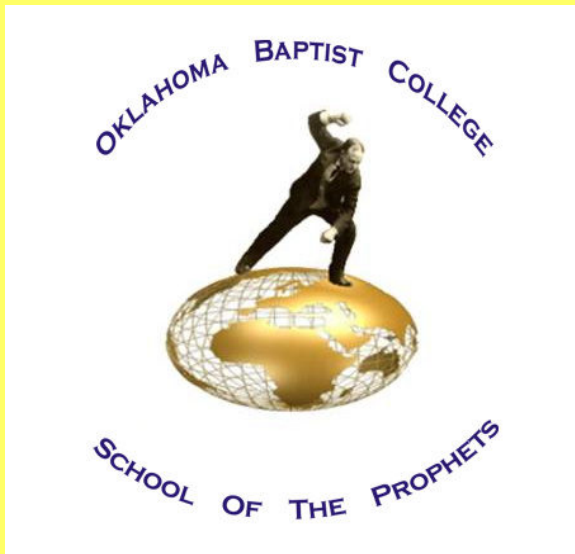

Registration Procedures

1. There will be a \$25.00 (non-refundable) fee for each participant. This fee includes all meals and housing.
